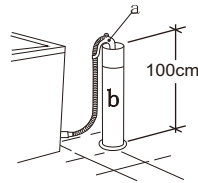
Remove package

- Remove package and take out the bottom board of the cabinet on the foam cover.
- Open the lid of washer's door and take out accessories.
- A trial operation or washing on the foamed cushion is strictly forbidden.



Placement of upper water drain hose

The height of drain hose ("a") should be between 100 cm. Diameter of "b" should not be less than 3 cm, and flow capacity not less than 40 L/Min.

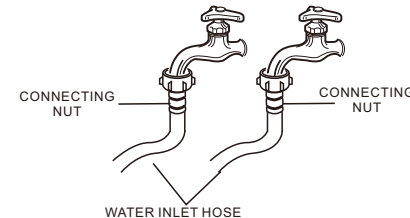
Installation of water inlet hose

1. Please choose a suitable faucet, and the outlet end face of the faucet should be flatwise to avoid water leakage.
2. Turn the inlet pipe to the tap
3. Screw the other end of the inlet pipe to the inlet valve connector of the washing machine.
4. After installation, open the faucet and check for water leakage.

※ Do not install the connector directly on the transfer head of the washing machine faucet. If the user has a special faucet for the washing machine, in order to prevent leakage, please unscrew the adapter and then connect the water inlet pipe to the faucet.

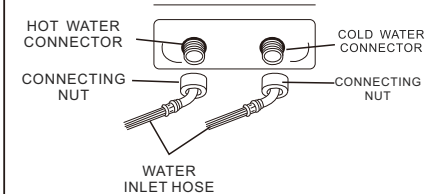
If you have both cold and hot water supplied, connect the inlet hoses by matching cold to cold and hot to hot.

1. Connect the water inlet hoses to the faucets by turning the connecting nuts.



Be sure the rubber rings are inside the connecting nuts.

2. Unscrew the lid of hot water connector in water mixing valve, and then connect the other end of water inlet hoses to the connectors in water mixing valve by turning the connecting nuts.



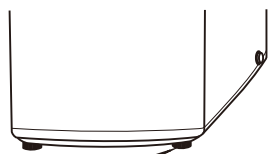

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard. The instructions for appliances connected to the water mains by detachable hose-sets shall state that the new hose-sets supplied with the appliance are to be used and that old hose-sets should not be reused. The openings must not be obstructed by a carpet. This appliance is for indoor use only.

Preparation before washing

1 Adjust the adjustable foot to make the washer be placed stable.

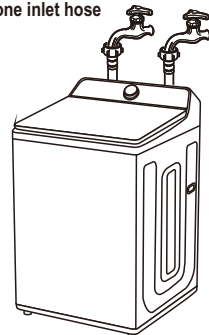


Adjustable foot (extend when clockwise rotating and shorten when counterclockwise rotating)

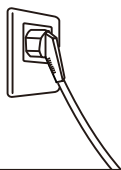
(Slightly incline the washer first and loosen the adjustable foot knob. Adjust the adjustable foot so as to ensure four corners of washer be steadily contacted with the ground. Then tighten the adjustable foot knob and lock it. If the ground is obviously not flat, correction should be made on the ground surface, otherwise the washer barrel will incline and knock the cabinet)

2 Install the water inlet hose.

Instruction of the washer operation panel

| 1 Power | Push the "Power" button to switch on the power. Under power-on mode, push it to switch off the power. Push the "power" button to switch on the power. If the switch off the power automatically after 10 minutes. |
| 2 Start/Pause | After the power is switched on, press it to start the machine. The washing machine running in accordance with the set operation procedures. After starting up, directly click this button, the machine will running according to commonly program. Press the pause key, we can reset the corresponding "progress" and "water level", press this key again, continue the former program or running according to the new set program. During working, push it to pause. During pause, push it to restart and go on working. |
| 3 Rinse | Selection of rinsing times After selecting the required main washing program, the corresponding rinsing frequency indicator blinks. When the rinsing frequency needs to be increased, press the rinsing button to select the rinsing frequency to be increased. After selecting the increased rinsing frequency, press the start button, the corresponding indicator will be on. Note: The number of rinses cannot be selected during the drum cleaning and drum air drying procedures. |
| 4 Wash | Wash time adjustment In the initial standby state, after selecting the washing program, the washing time can be adjusted. At this time, the indicator light of the corresponding washing time flashes. After pressing the start button to confirm the washing time, the indicator light will be steady on. |
| 5 Time Delay | In the initial standby state, if you want to select the "Delay" washing function, you can press the "Time Delay" button to make an appointment after the Settings of "Program", "Water Temp", "Wash" and "Rinse" are completed (refers to the time interval from the start of the delay laundry to the completion of the whole laundry process, calculated in hours). When the delay time is selected, after pressing the start button to start the delay, the digital tube will display the "Delay" time, and the delay indicator light will blink, and it will automatically decrease by 1 every hour. Once the system determines the time to enter the laundry procedure, the digital tube display remaining time (minutes) will be steady on, and the delay indicator light will turn off. After "Delay" is started to enter the appointment timing, other keys except "Time Delay" key and "Power" key are invalid. Press "Delay" key at this time, the original program parameters will be displayed for 3 seconds, and then continue to display "Delay" timing. After the delay is started, if you want to change the new delay time, you must shut down and reset it. Display 3-second program and process parameters when you press the "Delay" key during the reservation timing process: The "Process" light shows the process Settings, and the digital tube alternately displays "Time" and "water level". The "Spin Only" and "Self Clean" programs cannot set the "Delay" function. |

| 6 Water Level | In the initial standby state, the system gives the corresponding default water level after the program is set, and the default water level indicator blinks. You can also press the "water level" key to adjust the water level. After selecting the required water level and pressing the start key, the indicator will be on. |
| 7 Water Temp | Water temperature selection In the initial standby state, you can select the water temperature, the default state is "cold water", you can also press the water temperature button to adjust the water temperature. |

Soft is used for woollens, delicate clothes or lightly soiled clothes. Child Use this programme to wash children's laundry, and laundry for persons with sensitive skin or allergies. Child Lock Function

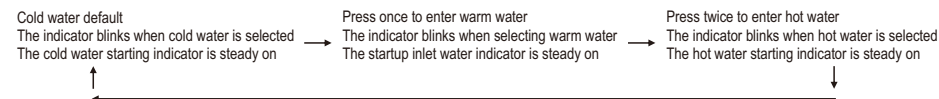
When the program is running, press the "Water Temp" + "water level" key for more than 2 seconds to enter the child lock protection state, and the remaining time of the digital tube is displayed alternately with "CL"; At the same time press the "Water Temp" + "water level" key for more than 2 seconds, the child lock protection is lifted.

In the child lock protection state, all keys except the power button are locked.

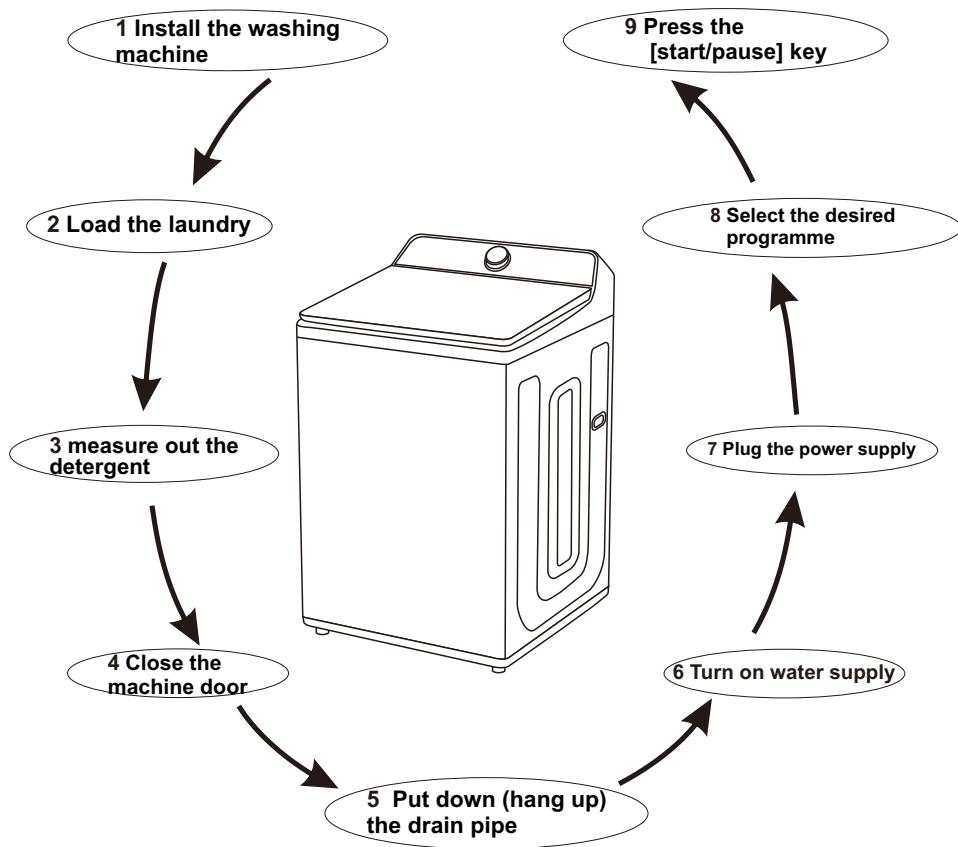
In the child lock protection state, if the lid is detected to be opened during washing, the washing machine will send a buzzer alarm E5. Within 5 seconds, the cover is closed and the fault is removed. After more than 5 seconds, the drainage tractor is opened and the drainage reaches the reset water level, and the fault is not removed after the drainage tractor is closed.

Dual water inlet selection mode

In the standby state, press the water temperature button to select the water inlet mode, the default is "cold water", press once to enter "warm water", press twice to enter "hot water", and then switch the cycle state. When selecting the water inlet mode, the indicator flashes; when selecting the water inlet mode and pressing the start button, the water inlet indicator is on. Turn off until the program is finished.



Quick start



Programme selection

- 1 Press the POWER button.
- 2 Select the proper water level and other attached functions.
- 3 press the start/pause key.

The wash stops

- When the wash stops, the buzzer will buzz continuously for 6 times and then the power will be automatically cut off.
- Turn off the water tap.
- Although the power can be cut off automatically, the power plug must be pulled out for the safety.

Operation Method

1.Preparation

Connect the water tap adaptor and water supply hose – Connect the power plug and grounding wire – Attach the external drain water hose and make sure to lay down the drain hose.

2.Laundry preparation

Put the laundry into the washer – Put detergent according to the water level displayed – Close the machine top lid – Press “Power” button to connect the power supply.

For clothes losing colour easily: Wash separately!











- Remove coins, pins, paper clips, nails, etc.
- Fasten buttons and close zippers.
- Do not wash items (such as paper diapers) other than laundry.
- Reverse clothes with surface likely to flake off.
- Use a brush to remove pet and human hair, sand, etc.
- Tie strings, etc

3.Programme selection

Variety of programs for different fabric type & wash purpose. You could select the wash program according to your special demand. The default knob indicates the program is “Normal”, you could select other programs if you need.

When the washer is in trouble, please contact local service office or the sales service department of our company and the customer should not dismantle the machine without permission.

If the washer can not work normally, or appear abnormality or alarms, please check and correct as follows.

List of faults and inspection

Note: During the de spin process, if washing are piled at one side of the spin barrel, it will cause unbalance of spin barrel resulting in striking. At this moment, the computer inside the washer will feel this unbalance phenomenon and will automatically correct it (fill in water Washing). However, if unbalance situation is not removed after continuous three corrections, which means the computer auto-correction can not resolve the problem. Then the user has to manually and evenly place the clothing inside the barrel to solve the problem.

Malfunction display and solutions

When the washer is in trouble, please contact local service office or the sales service department of our company and the customer should not dismantle the machine without permission.

If the washer can not work normally, and the abnormal indication is shown in the nixie tube window or the machine alarms, please check and correct as follows.

Warranty

This certificate is issued by DEFY APPLIANCES (PTY) LIMITED manufacturers of Defy, hereinafter the Company, to the original purchaser only, of the appliance described on the certificate and shall constitute the only warranty given in respect of this appliance.

The Company warrants to the original purchaser that for a period of TWO YEARS from date of purchase the appliance is free from defect under normal domestic use, both in workmanship and material, subject to the following conditions.

1. Repair or replacement of any part of this appliance, found by the Company to be defective, shall be at the election of the Company. The Company reserves the right to effect such service through any of its Service Divisions or Authorised Service Dealers. The cost of such service shall be borne by the Company in full, provided that the appliance is located no further than 50km from a Company Service Centre or an Authorised Service Dealer. Where the appliance is located beyond the 50km radius, the purchaser shall be liable for the standard travelling charges, as determined by the Company.
2. Cracked, rusted or corroded solid plates, vitreous enamelware, rust, cosmetic wear or cosmetic/external damage to products/components/fuses and lamps are specifically excluded from these warranties.
